208. **Declaration of Interest:**

210. **Confirmation of Minutes:**

Cllr Hardy asked that her request to obtain a quote for new toilets in the Village Hall be added. The minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 18 January 2017 were then **RESOLVED** as being a correct record of the proceedings thereat.

211. **Clerk's Report:**

- Clerk e-mailed SHTC regarding school buses and is waiting to hear from them.
- Clerk spoke to PCSO regarding problems on Shopping Centre Car park – see comments on Crime figures
- Clerk spoke to PCSO regarding parking on Homestead Road – they suggested a letter be delivered asking residents to park sensibly – see comments on crime figures
- Maintenance men have set mole traps in cemetery and checking regularly.

212. **Receive Information:**

- E-mail received from concerned parent regarding an accident on the Amenity Area. The provided photo evidence of the closing mechanism which had injured their child. Clerk told members that the closing mechanism had been changed immediately and parents had contacted clerk to say thank you for dealing with the matter quickly.
- January crime figures were discussed and these will be included in the next Parish Journal.

- Request from HART asking for a donation. Following discussion it was **RESOLVED** not to donate financially but to include their advertising poster in the Parish Journal. Clerk to speak to HART to see if residents of Thorngumbald use their facilities.
- Request from Citizens Advice asking for a donation – it was **RESOLVED** not to donate as there is no proof the money would be used for this Parish.
