The Christmas Lunch trip was discussed, and the following information was given out:

- The trip is open to members only until the October meeting, when invited guests can book any unsold seats

- The cost of the coach and lunch is:
 - ❖ For 2 courses: £21.50
 - ❖ For 3 courses £25.00
- This is the cost if all of the seats on the bus are filled. Any unfilled seats would mean the cost of the bus would rise to cover this
- Seating plans would be used to try and ensure everyone got to sit with their friends – no seats could be ‘saved’ by putting coats, etc. on them on arrival
