September Lunch Trip

Thursday 17th September, Rags Hotel, Bridlington. £15 for 2 courses

The trip would be in addition to the normal September meeting on the 8th September

Menu choices:

A: Homemade Hearty Steak Pie. Short crust pastry packed with chunks of slowly cooked beef in a rich guinness gravy. Served with chunky chips and mushy peas.

B: Rags own Beef Lasagne. Layers of pasta, Bolognese & béchamel sauce with grilled parmesan cheese.

C: Hand Battered Cod and Chips. Deep fried skinless fillet of cod in a crispy golden batter with chunky chips and mushy peas.

V: Tagliatelle Con Crema al Funghi. A bowl of tagliatelle pasta served with a rich creamy sauce with masala wine, mushrooms, feta cheese, and finished with fresh parmesan.

Desert Choices:

A: Ice Cream of the Day — 3 scoops of deliciously creamy locally produced 'Mr Moos' ice cream served with fresh cream and Cafe wafer curl

B: Home Made Cheesecake. A light and fluffy homemade cheesecake of the day on a buttery biscuit base.

C: Homemade Rich Chocolate Brownie. Served warm with white chocolate sauce and clotted cream ice cream.

The members were informed that a sheet would be passed around at the July meeting (Summer Social), along with printed menu sheets, for members to indicate their choices, and pay the deposit which Glenda would inform us of.
